THIS IN Focus

Each month we will be reporting on some current issues affecting the nation of Canada. Join us as we look at these critical issues:

MARCH 10 - Euthanasia/Assisted Suicide

Bill C-14 was passed into legislation in June 2016. Under this legislation, medical assistance in dying is legal if the eligibility criteria are met and the procedural safeguards are followed. In December, CTV news reported that more than 744 people have died by euthanasia in Canada since it was decriminalized on June 17, 2016.

MARCH 24 - Legalized Marijuana

In 2015, the government of Canada committed to legalizing, regulating, and restricting access to marijuana. The Task Force finished its work and a report was made available in December of 2016. Evidence-based legislation will be introduced to Parliament for consideration this spring.

A Sudden Interruption

Recently, after falling and cutting my head open in an icy parking lot, I headed to the emergency room with my husband. I told God that I didn't have

time for this, but He had other plans because soon a man named Gary was wheeled into the room with us. He was in a similar predicament after falling on the ice and breaking his foot.

After the doctor fixed my injury, my husband, JT, began to converse with Gary and offered to give him a pair of crutches from our garage and to drive him home. n interesting proverb is found in Isaiah 32:8: A generous man devises generous things, and by generosity he shall stand. It's wonderful for people to be known for their generosity; yet this verse also describes God—for as John 3:16 tells us, God so loved the world that He gave. God is generous and plans generous acts.

We see this in the story of the poor widow who tells

Elisha she has nothing but a jar of oil. He answers, "Go, borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbours—empty vessels; do not gather just a few" (2 Kings 4:3). It's a step of faith for her to scour the neighbourhood for empty vessels. Yet when she obeys, a miracle occurs. She pours out the oil, filling all the empty jars.

If we are expecting God to do a miracle, He is expecting us to do our part to have the faith to build the vessels for Him to fill.

I love to tell the story of CBN's first bank account. My father had filed the articles of incorporation for CBN, although he had virtually nothing. He wanted to have a vessel for God to fill—such as a bank account. So he went to a bank near the TV station that God had told him to claim in Portsmouth, Virginia. After he filled out the forms and picked out the cheques,

the clerk told him, "It's customary to make an initial deposit."

He only had \$3.25 in his pocket, and he needed a quarter to pay the toll home—so he gave her the three wrinkled dollar bills. Smiling sweetly, she said, "The cheques cost \$6." Dad quickly asked, "Can I have that on account?" For some reason, she agreed. And as I look at CBN's ministry today, I see how much has

come from that negative \$3 deposit!

Each of us should construct vessels for God to fill—in our lives, our personal finances, and what we want from God for the future. When we start with so little, He gets all the glory. He is the one who calls us, saves us, inspires us, enables us, and provides for us.

The most precious thing we have is time, and the best way to invest it is preaching the Gospel to every nation, tribe and tongue. We want to spend our time on things that will lead to great joy in heaven.

Isaiah 61:11 promises, *As the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.* Some plant while others water or weed, but it is always God who gives the increase. God bless you.
