At times, we endure trials and seasons so difficult that we wonder how in the world we will ever make it through. But, as Christians,

we've been purposefully designed by God to endure and spiritually prosper from life's trials. Hebrews 13:5 gives us the reason: *I will never leave you nor forsake you.* When God created you, He established your ending from your beginning (see Isaiah 46:10), placing a promise in you and on you before you encountered a single problem. Fighting Arthritis With Food

How an anti-inflammatory diet can alleviate pain

or anyone suffering with arthritis, best-selling cookbook author
Holly Clegg says, "I believe what you eat makes a difference in
better health." In her book, *Eating Well to Fight Arthritis*, she shares
how an anti-inflammatory diet can help alleviate arthritic pain—and offers
recipes that can minimize symptoms.

Writing the book for her loved ones dealing with arthritis, her chapter "Toss the Fork" features food for those whose stiff hands can't operate eating utensils. For a friend with severe rheumatoid arthritis (RA), she wrote "No Fuss Foods"—simple recipes she could fix easily for family meals.

Holly even has a chapter called "Bone Building" to help combat osteoporosis. It has recipes high in calcium and vitamin D, based on her own need for better bone health.

Although Holly attended London's Cordon Bleu cooking school, she specializes in everyday, nutritious easy meals. She was ahead of her time in seeing the connection between health and eating 25 years ago.

In addition to her recipes, Holly includes these tips to reduce inflammation and joint pain:

- Maintain a healthy weight by eating the right kinds of foods.
- Eat foods high in vitamin C (strawberries), high in carotenoids (red, yellow, orange fruits and veggies—sweet potatoes), and high in omega-3 fatty
- Fill up with fiber (beans, oatmeal) to reduce inflammation.

- Fight fatigue with a balanced diet of complex carbohydrates, protein, and unsaturated fats and try not to skip meals.
- Ease the side effects of arthritis medications—use gingersnaps, ginger candy or ginger ale to reduce nausea.



MARCH 9 — Update on Pornography

The Importance of Forgiveness

In the Bible, priests would stand and pray the blessing that God gave Aaron for the people: "The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace" (Numbers 6:24-26). For God promised, "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them" (v. 27).

This is a relationship blessing. It is being in God's presence, where His face shines upon us and we find *shalom*—the peace of God. Without His presence, there is no peace.

Jesus refers to this imagery, saying, "Whenever you stand

praying"—then continues, "if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses" (Mark 11:25-26). If we hold onto unforgiveness, our prayers go nowhere.

Jesus was beaten, spit upon, rejected, crowned with thorns, and nailed to a cross—yet He said, "Father, forgive them." He would rather have a relationship with the Father than hold onto offenses. He knows the Aaronic blessing is the key. If we have His presence, we have everything.

Another image of the priestly blessing is in 1 Timothy 2:8, when Paul says, *I want the men everywhere to pray, lifting up holy hands without anger or disputing* (NIV). Where there is anger and disputing, there is no anointing. Paul also says in Ephesians 4:26, "*Be angry, and do not sin*": do not

let the sun go down on your wrath.

This is why we should pray, "Lord, am I holding anything against anyone? I don't want to keep a grudge, because it takes away from my relationship with You. I want Your face to shine upon me. I

want Your presence all through me. And I want my heart transparent before You."

He will forgive anything if we ask—and when we have a clear conscience, we can pray with power. As 1 John 3:21-22 promises: *Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God. And whatever we ask we receive from Him.*
