





AN ETERNAL BLESSING



God has poured out His grace on us... forever.

If you look at the headlines, you may wonder how this can be a time of blessing. Yet we do indeed give thanks, for God has poured out His grace upon us. Think of Jesus—leaving the glory of heaven to be born in a stable, facing every temptation yet living a sinless life, knowing He would bleed and die for people who are rejecting Him, and still He said yes.

The Apostle Paul, who suffered greatly as he spread the Gospel, says in 2 Corinthians 4:15, *For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God.* Paul sees past his circumstances and looks forward to “the many” who will give thanks.

He continues, *Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day* (v. 16). Paul knows his body is dying. Imagine the scars from being beaten, shipwrecked, stoned, and left for dead. Even so, his spirit is renewed daily.

Then he makes this amazing statement: *For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal*

weight of glory (v. 17). Compared to Paul’s suffering, can we say our own problems are “light afflictions”?

He explains his perspective in verse 18: *We do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.* Paul keeps his vision fixed on the risen Christ in heaven—a city whose builder and maker is God. And he’s concentrating on how to populate that city with multitudes of people. These light afflictions are for a moment, while God’s glory is for all eternity.

Heaven will be filled with praise, for Revelation 5:13 tells us that every creature will declare: *“Blessing and honour and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!”*

And so Paul says in 1 Thessalonians 5:18, *In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God.* This is why, in every circumstance, no matter what we’re going through, we can give thanks. God bless you.
