# WHY ARE MORE PEOPLE LIVING PAST 100?

You can discover their secrets



*The key to a long life could be in your gut.*

People over 100 comprise the fastest-growing segment of the global population. International studies predict the world will have more than 3 million centenarians by 2050.

Dr. Steven Gundry, author of *The Longevity Paradox: How to Die Young at a Ripe Old Age*, says he knows the secrets of the centenarians. Topping his list of what it takes to live a vibrant, disease-free life is a healthy gut—an intestinal tract brimming with good bacteria. “When we look at 105-year-old people around the world, they carry the diverse gut microbiome of 30-year-old people,” Gundry observed. “They don’t become infirm, they don’t get cancer, they don’t get Alzheimer’s.” The key to a healthy gut is avoiding processed food that wipes out good bacteria. According to Gundry, the herbicide glyphosate is “probably the biggest health problem that people are unaware of.” It’s in many breads, crackers and cereals, including granola. He warned that glyphosate can cause a “leaky gut,” releasing bacteria and toxins that can trigger migraines, chronic fatigue, and autoimmune diseases like celiac. Antibiotics and common painkillers also harm the gut microbiome.

Robust old-timers often practice intermittent fasting—going without food for a minimum of 12 hours within a 24-hour period. Studies show fasting helps prevent atherosclerosis, Alzheimer’s disease, heart disease, and possibly cancer, while boosting the immune system.

Gundry also explains that women who exercise routinely during their lifespan have a 90-percent reduction in Alzheimer’s compared to women who don’t.

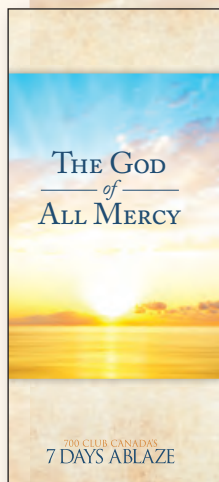

# HOW TO HAVE FAITH FOR HEALING

**J**esus said in Matthew 21:22 that you'll receive whatever you ask in prayer, believing. So how do you pray in faith?

First, when asking God for anything, it's important to have an attitude of thanks. Philippians 4:6 says, *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.*

That doesn't mean you thank God for your problems; instead, thank Him for what He is about to do! This shows you trust Him.

Psalm 103:2-3 gives this great promise: *Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: who forgives all your iniquities.*

How wonderful to know that when you turn to God, He will cleanse you from every sin. *"Come now, and let us reason together," says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow"* (Isaiah 1:18).

Also, be sure to forgive anyone who has ever harmed you. Ephesians 4:32 says, *Be kind ..., forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.*

Psalm 103:3 has another great promise: *He heals all your diseases.* Jesus accomplished this on the cross, and Isaiah 53:5 says, *By His stripes we are healed.* That's why you can look at any illness and say, "You're part of all the diseases that Jesus has already healed, so you must leave right now."

God is looking for faith. As 2 Chronicles 16:9 tells us, *"For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart*

*is loyal to Him."*

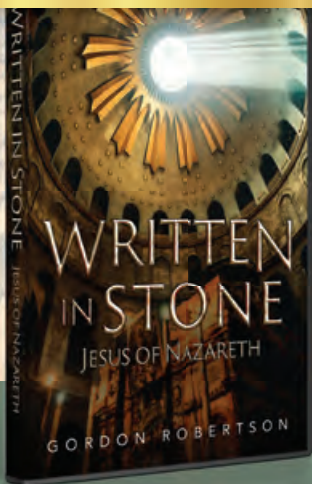
So have faith to believe, then let the Lord do the rest—because He stands by His Word to perform it. May God bless you as you pray in faith!
