During the peak lockdown period of the pandemic in British Columbia, UGM served up to 30 percent more meals per day to fill some of the gaps.

"I'm scared. I've never been unemployed, never needed help. This was my first-ever meal at UGM... and it was great. I have a belly full of food, and after talking to staff, I'm feeling encouraged."

YOU SAFELY SHELTERED THE HOMELESS!

UGM's 72 shelter beds were in four smaller rooms, rather than one large space, designed specifically with dignity and illness control in mind.

"I'd be in a way different—way worse—position if I couldn't stay in UGM's shelter. With my health already in rough shape, I don't think I'd survive this pandemic if I had to live out on the streets."

YOU COMFORTED AND NOURISHED THOSE IN DISTRESS!

During the initial months of the pandemic, UGM saw a significant increase in food hamper requests for families. Dozens of families, seniors, and single mothers were able to have their worries eased about how to provide food for their families!


"UGM is putting forth a lot to make sure that families are going to make it through. Knowing I can come here makes me feel safe."

None of this would be possible without you!



At an important point in Israel's history, the prophet Samuel told the people, *"Come, let us go to Gilgal and renew the kingdom there"* (1 Samuel 11:14).

Gilgal was where the Israelites had entered the Promised Land. At Joshua's command, the priests carrying the Ark of the Covenant stepped into the Jordan, the river parted, and the people crossed over on dry ground.

Joshua then took 12 stones from the riverbed and set them up as a reminder for future generations. Why? *"That all the peoples of the earth may know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty, that you may fear the LORD your God forever"* (Joshua 4:24).

This was the beginning of the nation of Israel.

Other nations also have geographic locations as reminders of their founding.

In the United States, there is Cape Henry, Virginia, where in 1607 the first permanent English settlers planted a cross, made a covenant, and dedicated the land to the Lord.

There's also Plymouth, Massachusetts, where 400 years ago this month, the Pilgrims signed the Mayflower Compact. Their desire was to become a city on a hill that could show the world what people can do when they wholeheartedly believe in God and follow His ways.

This echoes Jesus' words in Matthew 5:14, *"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden."*

The most important place for anyone in the world to renew our individual covenant with the Lord is in our own hearts.

So let's recommit ourselves to Jesus as Lord of all. Let us also rededicate ourselves to following His commands and shining the glorious light of the Gospel into all the world. God bless you!


