AN END TO FOOD ALLERGIES?

Unique treatment can provide relief from worry



If you suffer from food allergies, Dr. Kari Nadeau might have the answer.

A food allergy can be life-threatening to a child and a constant source of anxiety for parents, who know firsthand how even a small exposure can threaten the health of their child.

Thankfully, researcher and physician Dr. Kari Nadeau has found a unique treatment that can give children and their parents relief from the constant worry. Her approach is detailed in her book, *The End of Food Allergy: The First Program To Prevent and Reverse a 21st Century Epidemic.*

The treatment is a strategy called immunotherapy, which is the controlled gradual reintroduction of the allergen to the body. The method must be well controlled and done under the care of a knowledgeable doctor, because eating the same food to which they're allergic can result in a dangerous reaction. The process takes time, as the amount of the allergen consumed is slowly increased by the doctor. Eventually, the person should become desensitized and able to eat more of that food item without having a reaction.

Sloan Barnett, co-author of the book with Dr. Nadeau, has two children who went through this program. "They enrolled my two children in clinical trials," she says, "one through Stanford, one through Harvard, where they underwent oral immunotherapy," a process that is described in the book.

Her children, now grown, are still careful about what they eat because of their history with food, but they no longer worry about a severe allergic reaction.

The role of prayer that Strand is describing is not just important in gathering the news, it permeates everything CBN News does.

That's why Paul writes, *With the Lord's authority I say this: Live no longer as the Gentiles do, for they are hopelessly confused* (Ephesians 4:17).

Instead, Paul says in 1 Corinthians 2:16, *But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.*

Jesus was sometimes vexed by what His disciples were thinking and what the Pharisees were saying. Those two groups seemed to upset Him the most. He didn't seem to be upset with the tax collectors, the prostitutes, the lepers, or the Romans. And in Matthew 8:10, Jesus tells a Roman centurion, *"I haven't seen faith like this in all Israel!"*

So should we be upset when people who don't know God do strange things? They can't possibly think the way Christians think because they don't know Jesus or have the mind of Christ. If you thought there was no heaven and there are no consequences to our behaviour on earth, how would you live? This is why their thoughts are foolish.

As Christians, we came out of this thought pattern yet unfortunately it can still stay with us. The two kingdoms are at war in our own minds. We are reminded in 1 Timothy 6:12, *Fight the good fight for the true faith. Hold tightly to the eternal life to which God has called you.*

Jesus fulfilled every part of the law so we don't have to; yet what should we do with our liberty? What are our aspirations? How do we orient ourselves?
