

#### **How Do You Suffer?**

That may seem like a really odd question, but it is one that James, the brother of Jesus, explores in the book

bearing his name. He challenges his readers to *consider it pure joy* ... whenever you face trials of many kinds (James 1:2 NIV). As I read these words, I ask myself, "How is this possible? Why should I do this? What will be the result?"

James begins by stating the reality that suffering is a part of life. He uses the word "trials." We all have our own battles to fight and these battles expose what we really believe about God, our situation, and ourselves. For this reason, James claims that it is these trials that can actually strengthen our character, our resolve, and our faith.

James reminds us that if we are willing to persevere (James 1:3-4) we will not only find victory in our current battles, but we will be stronger for future ones. The word *perseverance* carries the image of a soldier in training who carries a heavy pack in the intense heat to build up endurance. It is the heavy training, or "trials," that make him faster and stronger; they actually make him better.

So, what should you do when you face suffering? James says you should ask God for wisdom. In other words, trust in God's character and His Word (James 1:5-7). If we do this, we will receive the crown of life (James 1:12). We will have joy in knowing that we overcame and became stronger as a result. We will receive the reward of a life lived well.

## YOUR BRAIN HEALTH

How managing your thoughts can improve your life

As a guest on the CBN News program *Healthy Living*, Dr. Daniel Amen shared how you can be happier by managing your brain health. He is a Christian, a psychiatrist, and the author of *Your Brain Is Always Listening*: *Tame the Hidden Dragons That Control Your Happiness*, *Habits*, *and Hang-Ups*.

The dragons are thoughts that sabotage your well-being, and he offers tips for managing them.

In an interview with medical reporter Lorie Johnson, Dr. Amen recommended writing down your thoughts whenever you feel sad, mad, nervous, or out of control—and then asking yourself if it's true. This helps in

the process of controlling what goes on in your mind.

Dr. Amen has been doing brain scans for 30 years with some eye-opening results.

"What we found is your moment-by-moment thoughts either make your brain work better or they make your brain worse. That when you focus on what you love about your life, your brain is healthier," he explained. "When you

focus on what you're afraid of, what you're angry about, it actually drops the function in your frontal lobes, so your decisions aren't going to be as good."

One strategy from his book includes positivity bias training, which trains your brain to look for the bright side.

"Whenever I go to bed at night, I ask myself, 'What went well today?' And it's a treasure hunt every night," he said. "I'm on a treasure hunt to just look for the small moments, I call them micro moments, of happiness, because I'm nudging my brain to look for what's right rather than what's wrong."

#### How important is it to fast?

**LORIE:** It's really important—and not something that we necessarily want to do. Fasting is actually a tool. It helps us change our hearts before God and offer more of ourselves to Him. Romans 12:1 says, Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship (NIV). Fasting is an act of worship that changes your heart. It makes you more fully aware of God and your need for Him. When we allow ourselves to feel empty, to allow hunger and pain to come to the surface, that enables us to then invite Jesus to heal us. A fast can be abstaining from an activity or time on social media. Put something aside so you can spend that time with God.




# THE POWER THAT NEVER FAILS

One of the great miracles in the New Testament happened when some people lowered their friend who was paralyzed down through the roof to be with Jesus. And Mark 2:5 records this wonderful phrase: When Jesus saw their faith.

Faith is visible to God. He sees when you believe. Many times faith is a process. Often on *The 700 Club*, people hear a word of knowledge and say, "That's for me; I'm going to take that"—and they have an instant

reaction. Their bodies respond immediately.

Why? Because God's power is always on. His healing is always available. The cross is always available to you. As 1 Peter 2:24 says, He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.




His power is constantly there; it's not something He turns on and off. And faith accesses that incredible power.

But instead, we should say, "I haven't lost anything. I haven't lost God. I haven't lost Jesus. I haven't lost His power. I'm going to act on my faith."

Now, what medical condition are you facing? God's power is right there for you. It's always on. His power doesn't flicker or waver. What you need is to believe, and to rely, and to trust, and to act on your faith. Don't allow doubt to creep in. So let's believe, and the Lord will do all the rest.
