Free to Eat Our Vegetables

Nobody likes rules that are imposed upon them. I think this is why so many people wrestle with some of the

requirements that are found in the Bible. We can be tempted to think that they are restrictive, oppressive and limiting. If you feel that way, I would like to offer another perspective.

When my children were growing up, we wanted them to eat their vegetables... a passion they did not share. I was tempted to do what many parents do and force them to eat them—either through punishment ("you can't leave the table until you eat them") or enticement ("I will give you candy if you eat them"). The problem with this approach is that it framed vegetables as being bad, something that had to be endured. Instead, I tried to make vegetables a fulfilling option. I presented the reasons why eating the vegetables were optimal and I didn't let them sneak junk food in between meals. I also ate all my vegetables.

I think it is the same with God's law. We often want to punish those who don't follow the "rules" or entice them with some cheap incentives. The better way is to let God's law work on my heart. When I let the intent of the law (love) become more important than the letter of the law (religion) people are set free. This is the Jesus way! This is why Paul said we know that the law is good if one uses it properly (1 Timothy 1:8 NIV).

FINDING VICTORY OVER FATIGUE

How healing the gut can increase your energy

If you depend on that afternoon cup of coffee to keep going, you're not alone. Chronic tiredness is becoming an epidemic. And not just in older Americans.

Dr. Steven Gundry, author of *The Energy Paradox: What to Do When Your Get-Up-and-Go Has Got Up and Gone*, says this rampant exhaustion can be caused by a leaky gut. He says we can stop leaky gut and has

devoted the last 21 years in teaching people how to do just that.

The first step, Gundry says, is to avoid taking antibiotics when not needed. While these livesaving drugs are sometimes necessary, people should steer clear of using them when they don't need to, such as to treat a viral infection, he says.

"It turns out antibiotics kill off most of the good bugs in our intestines that actually protect us from leaky gut," says Gundry.

The next step involves increasing healthy bacteria in the gut, which are called probiotics. These can be found in probiotic supplements and certain foods and drinks such as yogurt, fermented vegetables like kimchi, and drinks like kombucha and kefir.

Dr. Gundry says it's critical to feed the healthy bacteria in our gut with so-called prebiotics. Healthy bacteria prefer eating fiber, which is in most vegetables including leafy greens, onions, sweet potatoes, and most other foods in a grocery store's produce department.

Gundry suggests, when possible, avoid taking too many certain overthe-counter medicines such as ibuprofen. He also cautions against the use of antacid medications, also known as proton pump inhibitors, which he said should not be taken longer than two weeks.

Live like Jesus. Life has lots of responsibilities, so how do we fulfill them? Not hurried. Working with Jesus... freely and lightly. Let's live more like Jesus and ruthlessly eliminate hurry from our life so that we can live this life with greater ease and grace.



60 Years of Broadcasting

It's amazing to reflect on the past 60 years and consider all that God has accomplished through CBN, thanks to the dedicated prayers and support of partners like you!

Now, as we look to the future, I believe that you and I are about to come into a whole new appreciation of God's power. He is preparing to give us new designs and new avenues so that, together, we can fulfill Jesus' command: "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15).

In our journey, it's important to remain humble before God and trust Him completely. Recently I was reminded of Moses' final sermon to the Israelites just before the people entered the Promised Land.

He tells them in Deuteronomy 9:1-2, "Hear, O Israel: You are to cross over the Jordan today, and go in to dispossess nations greater and mightier than yourself, cities great and fortified up to heaven, a people great and tall." He was speaking of the "giants" that the Israelite spies had thought were too big to conquer 40 years earlier.

Soon after Moses' sermon, God did an astounding miracle. The Jordan dried up, allowing the Israelites to cross over into the Promised Land. Yet as Joshua 3:13-17 tells us, the river did not stop flowing until—at God's command—the priests carrying the Ark of the Covenant took the first step into the water!

Today, we are about to come into a tremendous

inheritance that God has stored up for us—great new ways of delivering media to every nation, tongue, tribe and people. This has been our prayer for decades, and He is answering that prayer! We just have to take that first step.

Are we ready for God to do a new thing? You and I simply need to say, "All right, God; You want us to go in and take the land, so we will do it." And Jesus tells us in Matthew 19:26, "With God all things are possible."

Everything we have is a gift from God. We can't claim credit for any of it. Our entire future is from the hand of the Lord—and we thank Him for it.

Let's also remember the prophecy that was spoken over CBN decades ago, when my father was dedicating CBN's new studio in Portsmouth. We had gone from a little rundown shoebox studio to a larger place. Even so, it had a metal roof, so the sound of rain would drown out our productions! But it was a big deal, with a \$250,000 construction contract that was more money than we could really think about back in the 1960s.

Harald Bredesen, a longtime friend of CBN and a member of the board of directors, gave a word from God, declaring, "These days shall seem small in light of where I am going to take you."

Here we are, 60 years since CBN was founded and over 50 years after that prophecy, and it is coming

true. The technology now exists for us to bring the Gospel to all nations. All we have to do is say yes to the Lord. God bless you!
