Who or what can you trust in this world that is constantly changing? The Apostle John, in his Gospel, wrote a response to a turbulent

time in history where things were changing rapidly. The government had become corrupt, self-interested, and unstable. The social constructs were eroding, and the religious climate was becoming increasingly hostile. In these troubled times John reminded his readers that there was an unchanging truth that they could trust—in a world that had become untrustworthy. In John 1:1 we read, *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.*

We live in a world full of words. Words are powerful. The average person hears 20-to-30,000 words a day and these words shape who we are and who we become. Words can be used as tools to build or weapons to destroy. Into this reality, John boldly states there is a Word that we can trust above every other word because it is unchanging. This Word was "in the beginning" and so not even time can change it. As a matter of fact, every word we know and express is a synonym or antonym to this Word. It is this Word that gives meaning, direction, order, and salvation to those who are willing to hear and accept it.

John goes on to explain that this Word has a name... He is Jesus, the Son of God (John 1:14).

Why is this important? Because John reminds us today that there is a Word that you can trust in a world that is constantly changing. He *is the same yesterday and today and forever* (Hebrews 13:8).

STRENGTHENING YOUR IMMUNE SYSTEM

Simple ways to restore health

s COVID-19 continues to mutate, creating more and more variants, there are things we can do to protect ourselves. The most natural way to fend off any illness is to build our immune system. This can protect us from colds, viruses, and the flu. But how exactly do we develop strong immunity?

Dr. Bob Lahita, author of *Immunity Strong: Boost Your Natural Healing Power and Live to 100*, says some people inherit a strong immune system, but the rest of us have to work at it. That means managing our stress. "Stress is probably the most adverse influence that the immune system has," he explains.

Lahita recommends getting enough sleep and taking some time for yourself each day. He suggests getting at least six to seven hours of sleep per night and seeing your physician if you are having trouble sleeping.

Gut health also impacts our immunity. "Right now, it's a very popular thing to use prebiotics and probiotics. Basically, what you're doing is making sure that you have friendly bacteria to restore the flora, or the bacteria, in your gut," says Lahita. Ideally though, he mentions we should be getting probiotics and prebiotics from our diet by including yogurt and fermented foods.

Our lifestyle has a lot to do with having a healthy immune system, so he also recommends getting enough socialization, avoiding drugs and excessive alcohol, and only taking antibiotics when necessary because they destroy the good bacteria that help us fight infection. But as always, talk to your doctor before making any changes.

The Bravest Choice

There's a lot of pressure in our world to do something that matters—something that will make a difference. Maybe

you feel like you go about your everyday life and nothing you do really matters. I'm sure that's how Shiphrah and Puah felt. You ask... who? We read in Exodus 1:15-17 a brief account of two midwives: Shiphrah and Puah. Maybe they didn't think they were doing anything special as they went about their everyday lives, helping women give birth to their babies, until one very fateful day.

Then Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, gave this order to the Hebrew midwives, Shiphrah and Puah: "When you help the Hebrew women as they give birth, watch as they deliver. If the baby is a boy, kill him; if it is a girl, let her live." But because the midwives feared God, they refused to obey the king's orders. They allowed the boys to live, too. (NLT)

These women were given orders by an evil king who felt threatened by the growing numbers of the Israelite people. His solution was to kill all the baby boys! We see in these few verses that Shiphrah and Puah made a very brave choice. They refused to obey the king's orders and let the boy babies live. Why? They were more concerned about pleasing God than obeying the king.

Here were two relatively unseen women who essentially saved a generation of lives.

No matter what your status in society is, this is a lesson for all of us. Let's live each day more concerned with pleasing God than anyone or anything else. Who knows? You may have a part in saving a generation!


