Rest and Renewal Throughout this wonderful country, the summer can be such an invigorating time as we take advantage of the warm weather, spend time outside, and often go away on a vacation. Life is so busy and can be incredibly fast-paced, so taking time away from your regular schedule is incredibly important.

Remember how you felt as a child! The weeks in June led to your summer break, where the days felt long, you could sleep in, and often families went on holiday. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint (Isaiah 40: 29-31).
