## The Good Samaritan: More Than a Moral Lesson

The parable of the Good Samaritan isn't just a call to *do* better—it's a revelation of what Jesus has *done* for us.

We often read this story as a moral challenge: Don't be like the priest or the Levite—be the Good Samaritan. But look again. We're not the hero-in-the-ditch side drama. We're the broken one lying in the road—stripped of strength, dignity, and hope. And it is Jesus, the true Good Samaritan, who sees us.

He sees our distress. He stops. He comes near. He binds our wounds with His mercy and pours the oil and wine of the Holy Spirit into our pain. He lifts us up, carries us, provides for our healing, and promises to return.

This parable isn't just about what we must do; it's about what God does in us. It's not only a call to action—it's a vision of transformation. When we are seen, healed, and loved by Jesus, we begin to see others differently. Our proximity to His mercy changes how we perceive the hurting, the lonely, and the overlooked.

Jesus ends the story with this charge: "Go and do likewise." Not from guilt—but from grace. Once you've been rescued, you can't help but reach out. Love becomes who you are, not just what you do.

This week, let Jesus' mercy shape your vision—and your steps. See like the Samaritan. Love like the Saviour.






Sometimes, the miracles God gives aren't the ones we ask for, but the ones He knows we need.

Maybe you're waiting for a miracle right now. Don't overlook what God might be doing within you. Strength, forgiveness, peace, these are miracles, too. And often, they are the ones that transform us the most.

# Pray Until the Breakthrough

How often should you pray for the same thing? The Bible shows us two approaches. In Mark 11, Jesus speaks to a fig tree once, which withers from the roots. Then in verse 23 He says, *“Whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed ...,’ and does not doubt in his heart ... he will have whatever he says.”*

That’s the power of believing you’ve already received.

But in Luke 18:1-8, Jesus tells a parable so that we *“always ought to pray and not lose heart.”*

It’s the story of the persistent widow who keeps coming to the judge until he gives her justice. And Jesus explains that if even an unjust judge will respond, how much more will God, who loves us, respond to His people who cry out day and night?

So, which is right? Both are.

Sometimes the answer comes quickly. But when it doesn’t, keep praying. Stay in constant communication with the Lord, because He is the source of everything—life, faith, and power.

And while you’re praying, stay expectant. Don’t lose heart. Don’t give up. Your breakthrough may be just on the other side of one more prayer, one more moment of faith.

Jesus promises in Matthew 7:7-8, *“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.”*

So, whether you’re praying once or persevering for days, weeks, or even years, pray in faith. Then, when the answer comes, give thanks and rejoice in what the Lord has done.
