

## Trust the Unseen Work

Growth doesn't happen overnight. Plant a seed, and for weeks it looks like nothing is happening. Yet beneath the soil, roots are spreading,

and life is forming in ways unseen.

Our lives can feel much the same. We pray, we wait, we hope—and nothing seems to change. In those moments, it's easy to wonder, "Is God really working here?"

Simon Peter knew that struggle. After a long night of fishing with nothing to show for it, he was weary and discouraged. Then Jesus stepped into his boat and asked him to try again. From Simon's perspective, it made no sense. But when he obeyed, his nets overflowed with fish.

That miracle was never just about fish; it was about trust. God had been at work all along: in Simon's heart, in the timing, in preparing a moment that would reveal who Jesus truly was.

We often mistake silence for absence, but in John 5:17, Jesus said, "*My Father is always working, and so am I*" (NLT). Even when we don't see progress, He is active in the unseen places, aligning circumstances, strengthening us, and drawing us closer to Himself.

So, if your "nets" feel empty today, don't lose heart. What feels like waiting may be preparation. What looks like nothing may be the soil where God is cultivating something greater.

The real question isn't, "Is God working?" It's, "Will I trust Him long enough to see what He's been doing all along?"

God is at work in your life!

## Remade for God's Work

**H**ave you ever felt like God was asking you to do something that didn't suit you? Jeremiah understands. As a young man, he received God's call out of the blue—to be a prophet to the nations. And Jeremiah told God He must be confused: "*Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I cannot speak, for I am a youth*" (Jeremiah 1:6 NKJV). Didn't God know he wasn't equipped for this?

God replied, "*Do not say, 'I am a youth,' for you shall go to all to whom I send you*" (Jeremiah 1:7).

God's response could seem insensitive, but let's see how He first called Jeremiah: "*Before I formed you in the womb I knew you. ... I ordained you a prophet to the nations*" (Jeremiah 1:5).

God knew Jeremiah. He also knows us—inside and out—past, present, and future. And God is the Maker. He decides who we are and what we can do—before we are even born.

What's more, if we feel we aren't what we ought to be, we can ask Him to remake us. Jesus said, "*With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible*" (Matthew 19:26).

Once God heard Jeremiah's excuse, what did He do? Jeremiah 1:18 says, "*For behold, I have made you this day a fortified city and an iron pillar, and bronze walls against the whole land.*" God was remaking Jeremiah into what he needed to be in order to do what he was called to do.

So, what's God saying to you? Let this new year be the one where you stop resisting and start trusting.

## A VISION BORN IN FAITH

The story began in 1959 when a young Pat Robertson moved his family to the Tidewater region of Virginia with only \$70 and a clear calling from God. Although he did not own a television, he filed papers to establish The Christian Broadcasting Network, purchased a defunct UHF station, and stepped out in bold obedience. On October 1, 1961, CBN began broadcasting from WYAH-TV in Portsmouth, Virginia. The signal barely reached beyond the city limits, but God was already preparing a global impact.

## CBN REACHES CANADA

As CBN grew, its broadcasting footprint expanded across the United States and eventually into nations around the world. In 1974, Gospel-centred programming entered Canada through cable and satellite, marking the beginning of more than five decades of ministry here at home. Today, through broadcast, digital outreach, prayer ministry, and practical assistance, God is still using CBA to help fulfill the promise found in Habakkuk 2:14 (NKJV): *“For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.”*

Every program, resource, and outreach effort reflects this vision to glorify God and lead people to Jesus.

## Pride Goes Before Destruction

*Pride goes before destruction* (Proverbs 16:18 NIV). Those are sobering words—but they’re also deeply personal. Pride doesn’t always roar; sometimes

it whispers, “You’re doing just fine without God.” It convinces us that we’re the main character in our own story, that life works best when we’re in control.

King Nebuchadnezzar learned this the hard way. Standing on his rooftop, he looked over his kingdom and declared, “Look at what I have built!” (see Daniel 4:30). In that moment, he believed the illusion—that his success was his own doing. But God, in His mercy, allowed it all to crumble so the king could see the truth: “*Then I praised the Most High; I honoured and glorified him who lives forever*” (v. 34). When Nebuchadnezzar finally lifted his eyes toward heaven, his sanity—and his peace—were restored.

Pride is dangerous because it disconnects us from our Source. It builds walls instead of bridges, towers instead of altars. But humility brings us home. It reminds us that everything we have—our breath, our gifts, our influence—is from God and for God. So, as we begin a new year, let’s begin by acknowledging God’s hand in every moment and inviting His will—not ours—to lead the way.

Freedom begins the moment we release control and return glory to God. As Jesus modeled, true greatness is found not in ascending higher but in kneeling lower. When we humble ourselves—acknowledging God’s authority, obeying His will, and serving others—He lifts us up in due time.

Pride always leads to a fall, but humility always leads us back to freedom.
