SuperVerse:

Bible Reading Plan

SuperTruth:

Our relationship with God is the most important relationship we will ever have. We need to obey God when he tells us to do something and stand up for God even when others don't believe in him.

- When the Israelites were discouraged by the negative report from the other spies, Joshua and Caleb trusted that God would fulfill his promise. When we are discouraged, we can remember that all God's promises are fulfilled in Jesus.

- Gideon was a temporary judge sent to save his people in a time of need. Jesus is our true judge, defender, and savior. We just need to believe in him and trust him, just like Gideon did.

- Elijah was a great prophet who told people to repent and turn to God. John the Baptist fulfilled prophecies that said Elijah would return to prepare the way for the Messiah—Jesus.

- Thomas wrestled with believing something he did not see. Even though we have not seen Jesus, he reveals himself to us through the Bible, through the witness of others, and through the Holy Spirit. All we need to do is believe.
- By serving others, including healing and taking care of the poor, Philip was reflecting the life of Jesus. The passage the Ethiopian was reading points to Jesus as the ultimate servant, laying down his life for others.



SCAN TO WATCH
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BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

“Joshua & Caleb” Bible Background:



In this episode, the kids arrive in the land of Ophrah during a Midianite raid, and Gideon helps them hide from the soldiers. Later, Gideon is shown threshing wheat on the floor of a winepress. Normally, threshing—separating the grain from the chaff—was done on an open threshing floor, as seen in the *Ruth* episode. However, Gideon worked inside a winepress, to hide the grain from the Midianites. The picture on the right shows the ruins of an ancient winepress.

In Numbers 12, the Israelites are described as camping in the wilderness of Paran at a place called Kadesh Barnea. While camped there, the Lord instructed Moses to send spies into the land of Canaan. Many scholars identify Kadesh Barnea with the modern site of Ein el-Qudeirat, located just inside Egypt’s border. As a result, this area is traditionally associated with the spies’ report and the subsequent grumbling and rebellion of the Israelite congregation.

“Gideon” Bible Background:



“Elijah & The Prophets of Baal” Bible Background:



In this episode, God brings a drought on the land following Elijah’s proclamation, directly challenging Jezebel’s god Baal, who in Phoenician belief was the god of fertility and rain. Later, the same idol is invoked by 450 prophets (depicted in the image on the left) who dance and call on Baal from morning until noon to consume their sacrifice—but nothing happens. In contrast, Elijah drenches his sacrifice and the wood beneath it with water, and the Lord responds by sending fire that consumes them both.

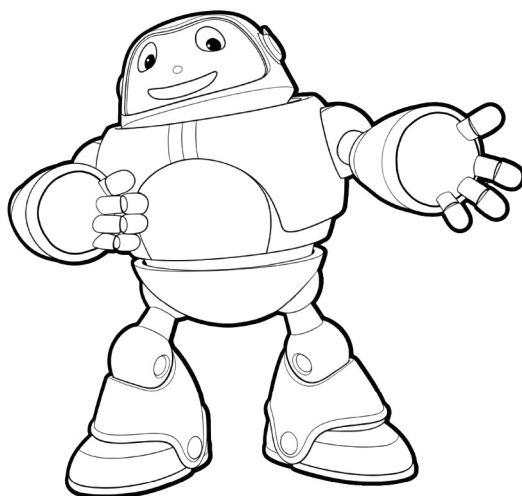
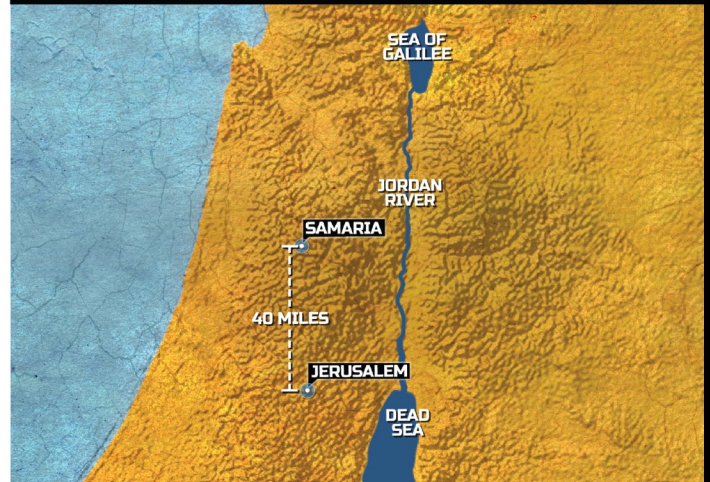
“Doubting Thomas” Bible Background:



While Chris and Gizmo begin the adventure in Jerusalem—a city mentioned 667 times in the Old Testament and 139 times in the New Testament—Joy arrives in Emmaus, where she meets Cleopas and another companion. On the road to Emmaus, they encounter the risen Jesus and continue with him to the village, located about seven miles from Jerusalem (Luke 24). Although the exact location of biblical Emmaus is debated, many historians identify it with El-Qubeibeh, shown in the image.

The children first encounter Philip in the city of Samaria, shown on the map on the right. Built on a large hill, Samaria lies about 40 miles north of Jerusalem and once served as the capital of the Northern Kingdom of Israel, roughly 700 years before Jesus' birth. By the time of Chris, Joy and Gizmo's adventure—shortly after Christ's ascension—the Northern Kingdom no longer existed, and Samaria was under Roman rule.

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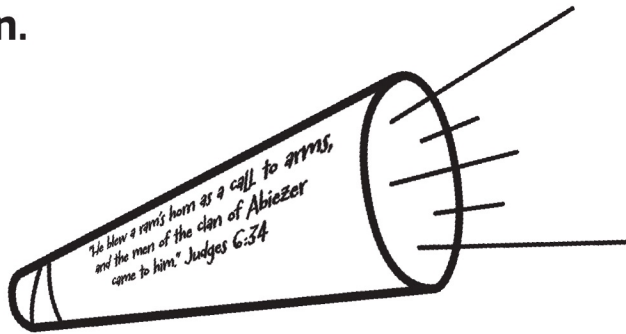

Step 3: Tape the outside edge of the paper and the smaller end of the horn.



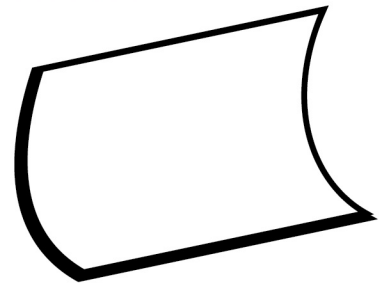
FINAL ROLLED UP PAPER HORN

Try to roll it so the verse appears on the top of the horn.

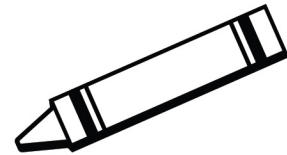

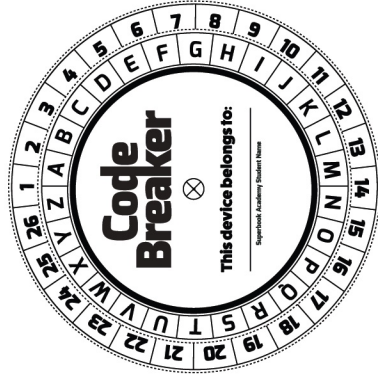


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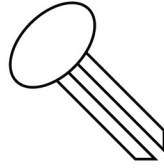


JUNE BIBLE READING PLAN Code Breaker

ITEMS NEEDED

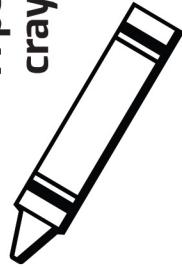


Code Breaker

Step 1

Print, cut out, and assemble the code breaker.

Step 2

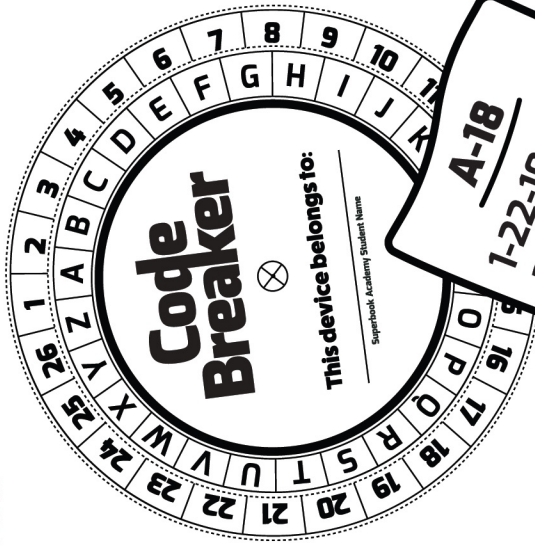
Turn the smaller wheel on the code breaker to set your code and mark down where the letter "A" lands. (For example, if the "A" is next to the number 18, then you would write down A-18.)

Step 3

Now if the code is set you can write a secret message using that code. Write down a number for each letter. For example, if you wanted to write J-E-S-U-S, with your code breaker set to A-18, you would write the numbers 1-22-10-12-10. See image to right.

Step 4

Once you write your code, give it to a friend so that they can figure out your secret message using the code breaker.

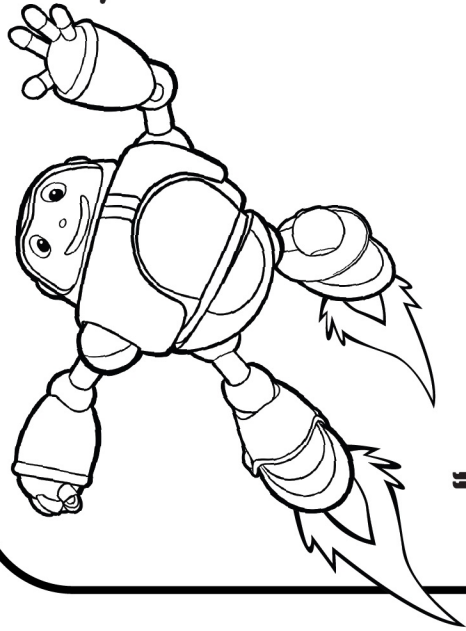
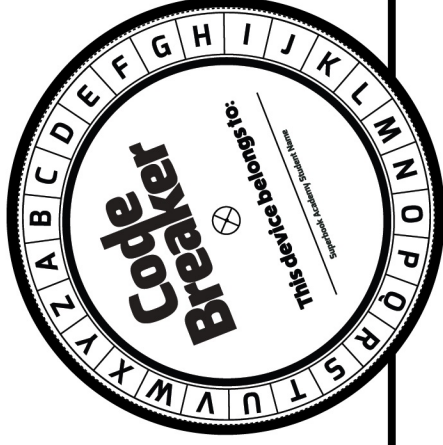
Code Breaker

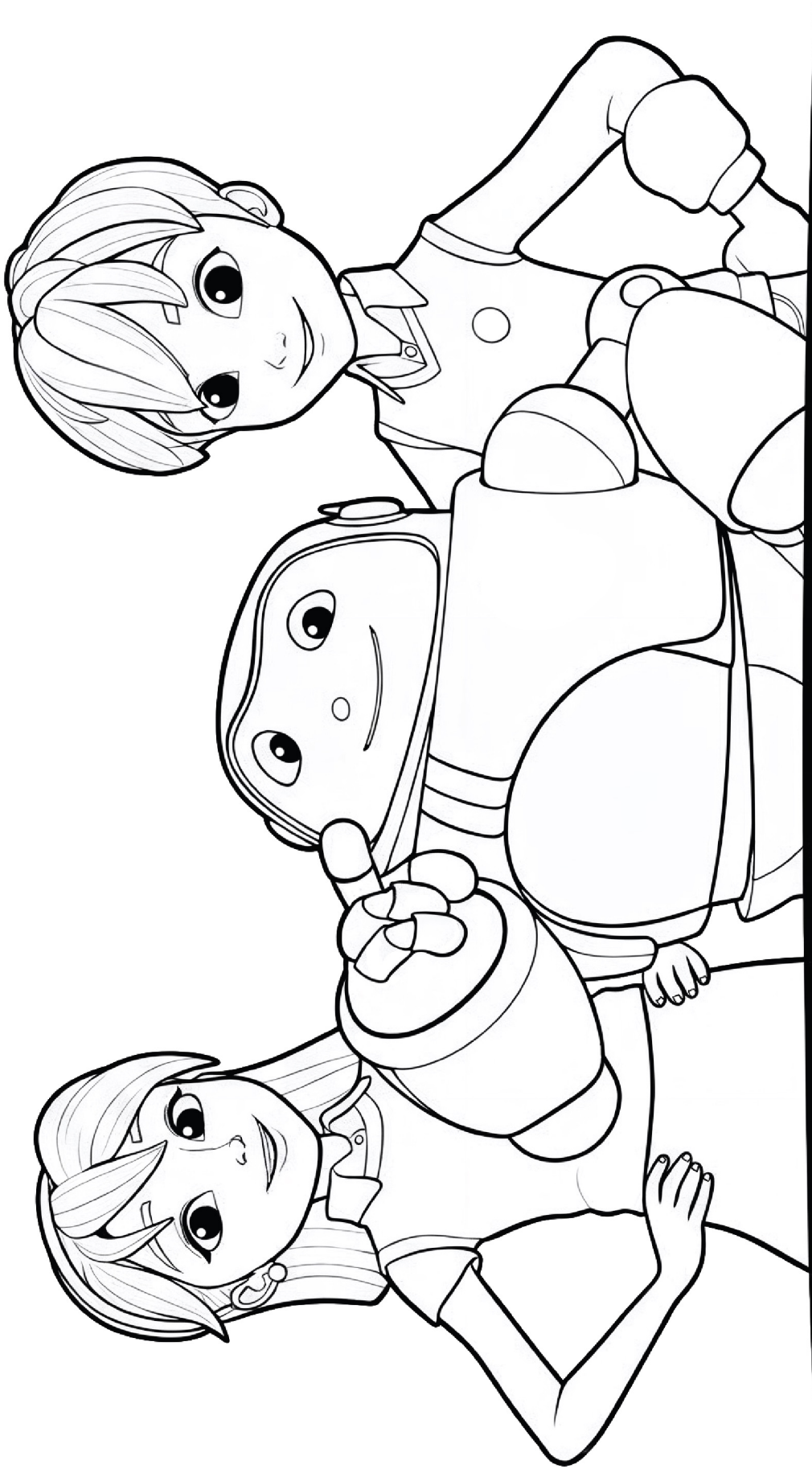
