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BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

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“Paul & the Unknown God Pt 1” Bible Background:



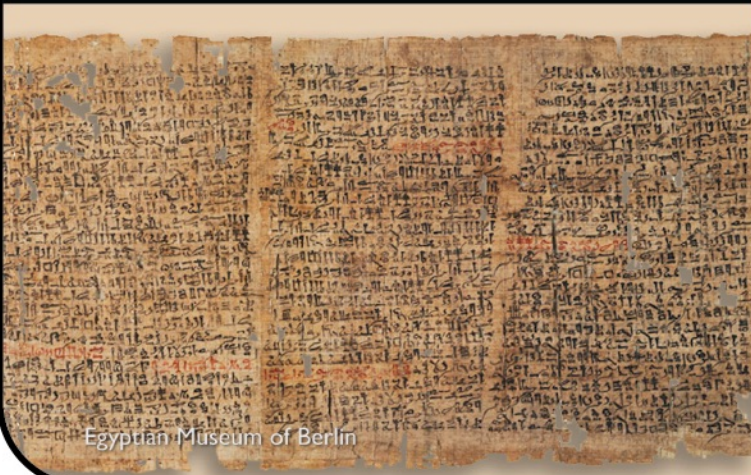
This episode takes place in Athens during Paul's second missionary journey and draws its title from his address at the Areopagus described in Acts 17. The Athenians worshiped many gods and even maintained an altar inscribed **“TO THE UNKNOWN GOD.”** Paul used this altar as a starting point to direct them to the one true God. The image on the left shows a bust of Epimenides, a well-known Greek poet who wrote the epic poem “Cretica” and is traditionally credited with advising the Greeks to build an altar to the Unknown God.

Paul spent about a year and a half in Corinth with fellow believers such as Aquila, Priscilla, Silas, and Timothy. Since workers of the same trade often lived and worked together, Paul—himself a tentmaker—stayed with Aquila and Priscilla and supported his ministry by making tents. The image on the right shows the ruins of a building called the **Agora of Corinth**, where Paul may have sold and repaired his tents.

In Exodus 7, the Lord demonstrates his power through Moses and Aaron by turning a staff into a serpent. The image on the left shows the Westcar Papyrus, which contains stories about Egyptian magicians, including accounts of court magicians turning their staffs into snakes. In the biblical account, however, Moses and Aaron's serpent proved superior by consuming the magicians' snakes.

BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND



"The Ten Commandments" Bible Background:



In this episode, the kids travel back to the time of Moses and join the Israelites at the base of Mount Sinai. The Israelites camped there for about a year, during which God met with Moses and gave him the Ten Commandments. Although the exact location of Mount Sinai is uncertain, tradition identifies it with a mountain now called Jabal Musa, shown in the image to the left.

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Although Saul was born in Tarsus, he was raised in Jerusalem, where he studied under the renowned Rabbi Gamaliel. A statue of Gamaliel is shown in the image to the right. Jewish tradition regards Gamaliel as one of the greatest teachers of the Torah—the first five books of the Bible. Many Jewish leaders rejected Jesus as the Messiah and sought to stop his message from spreading. Gamaliel even appears in Acts 5 urging the Sanhedrin to leave Peter and John alone as they stood trial for preaching Christ.

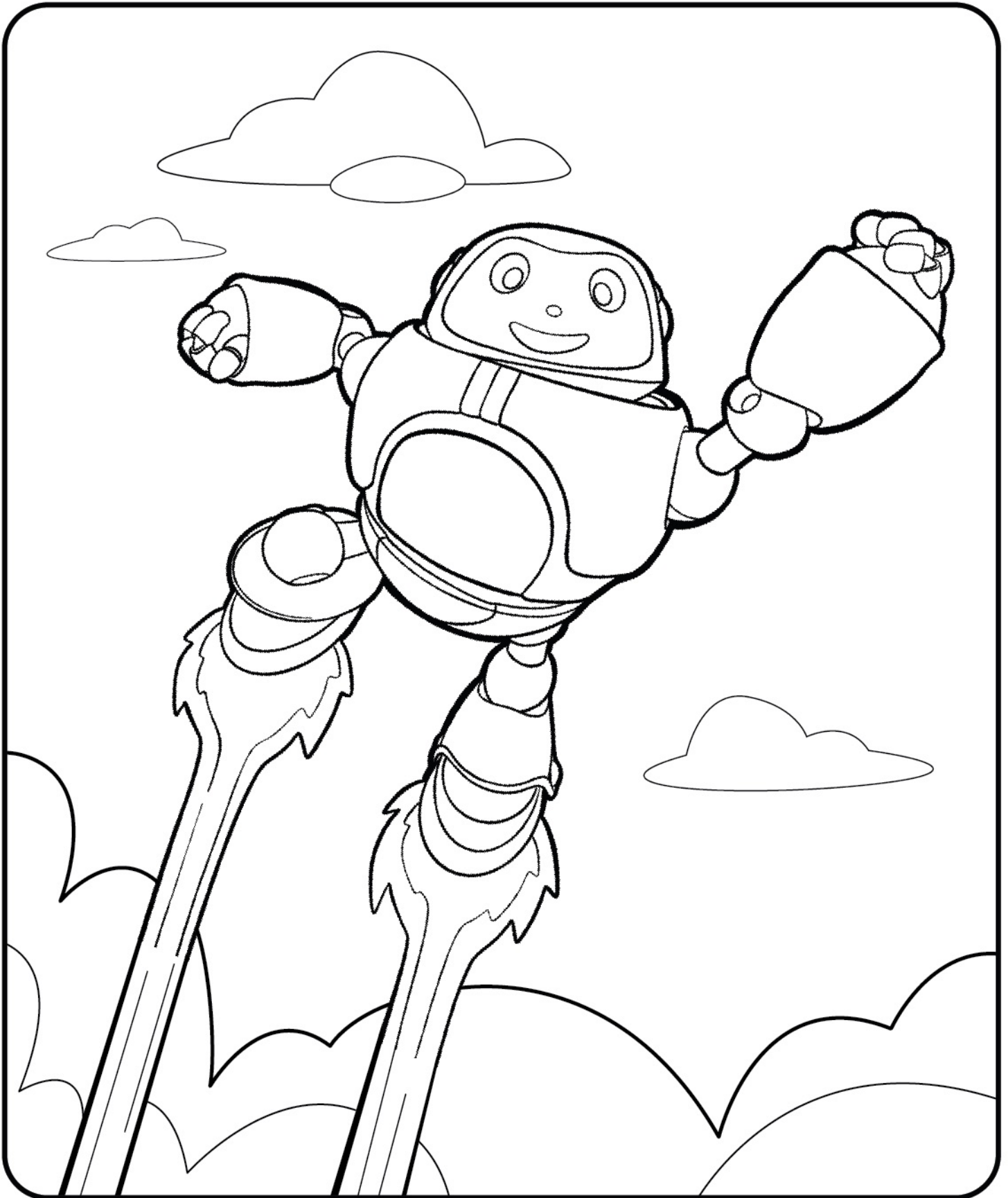


"Rescued!" Bible Background:



In this adventure, the kids meet Paul during his second missionary journey as he travels from Syrian Antioch to Pisidian Antioch, near Phrygia. In Pisidian Antioch, archaeologists have uncovered the remains of the Basilica of St. Paul, whose foundation stones date to Paul's time and may belong to a synagogue where he preached. From there, Paul traveled on to Troas and Samothrace, and finally walked from Neapolis to Philippi, where we meet Lydia and see her conversion and baptism.
