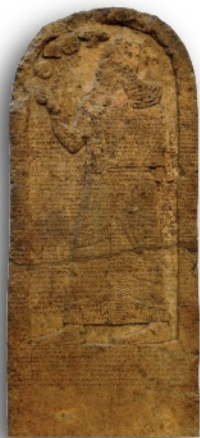

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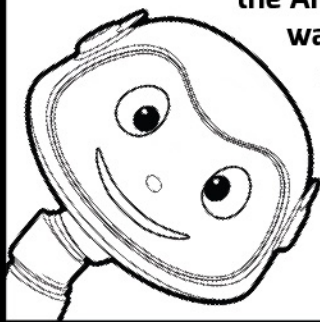
BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

“Naaman & the Servant Girl” Bible Background:



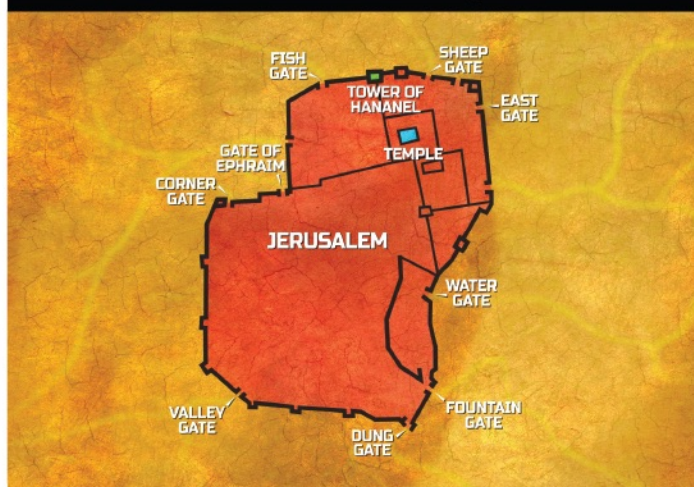
This map shows the city of Jerusalem and the wall that Nehemiah and the Israelites rebuilt in this episode. The task was daunting, relying on volunteer and untrained labor while facing opposition from figures like Sanballat of Samaria, Tobiah the Ammonite, and Geshem

the Arab. Yet with God's help, the wall was completed in just 52 days. Remarkably, portions of this wall can still be seen today—2,500 years later!



During the time of Naaman, Ben-Hadad II ruled Aram in Syria, which lay north of Israel. Before traveling to Israel to seek healing from his leprosy, Naaman had to obtain permission from his king. Although Syria often raided and fought against Israel, the two kingdoms occasionally joined forces. One such instance is recorded on the Kurkh Stele, a carved limestone monument that describes the Assyrian king Shalmaneser III's battle at Qarqar and notes King Ahab of Israel fighting alongside Ben-Hadad II of Syria against the Assyrian king, Shalmaneser III.

“Nehemiah” Bible Background:



“Job” Bible Background:



By examining details in the book of Job, scholars can estimate when Job lived. Because his wealth is measured in livestock and servants, and because he serves as priest for his own family, Job is often placed in the time of the patriarchs—during the era of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. The image to the left shows a wall painting called “People of Canaan,” discovered in the tomb of the Egyptian official Khnumhotep, and offers a glimpse of what Job and his family may have looked like during the time of the patriarchs.

BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND



"Paul & the Shipwreck" Bible Background:



In this adventure, the ship carrying Paul and the kids wrecked near Malta, an island about 50 miles southwest of Italy. While there, Paul met Publius, the island's chief official, and healed his father. Paul remained on the island for three months until better weather made sailing safe again. The image shows the remains of a Roman villa believed to be where Publius lived, and possibly where Paul stayed during his time on the island.

King Solomon undertook two major building projects in Jerusalem, the first of which was his palace—a project that took 13 years to complete. Although the palace no longer exists, archaeologists have uncovered clues to its design. The image on the right shows the top of a column discovered in Jerusalem that dates to Solomon's time, which many believe was part of a royal structure.



"King Solomon" Bible Background:



"Solomon's Temple" Bible Background:



Solomon was anointed king at the Gihon Spring, an underground water source outside Jerusalem. In addition to giving water, the spring was used for purification rites and other sacred ceremonies. About 200 years later, King Hezekiah built a tunnel to divert the spring's waters into Jerusalem, ensuring a reliable water supply even during times of war.

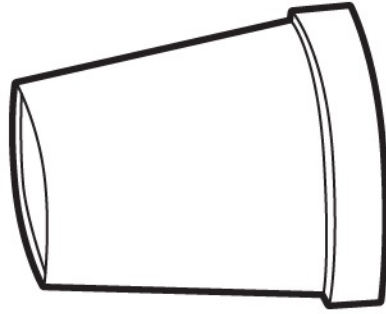

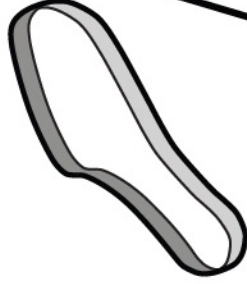


SOLOMON'S TEMPLE – Cup Tower Challenge

ITEMS NEEDED



Paper or Plastic Cups
Cups will be used for stacking.



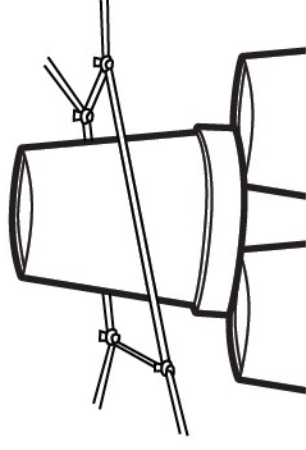
Rubber Band
The rubber band should fit snugly around the cup when it is not stretched..



Twine or Rope
Do not use thread, as it may snap during this challenge.

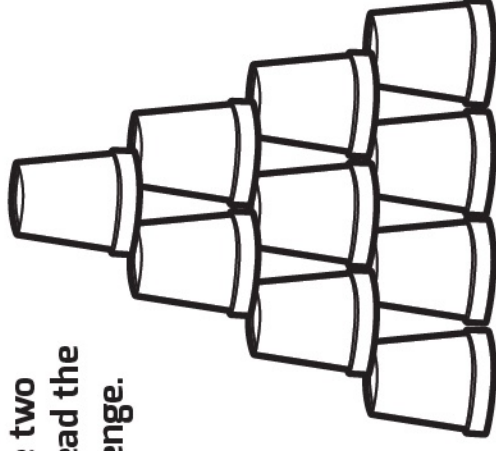
Step 1

Tie four pieces of rope to the rubber band.



Step 2

Have a partner join you and take two of the pieces of rope. You will lead the other person through this challenge.



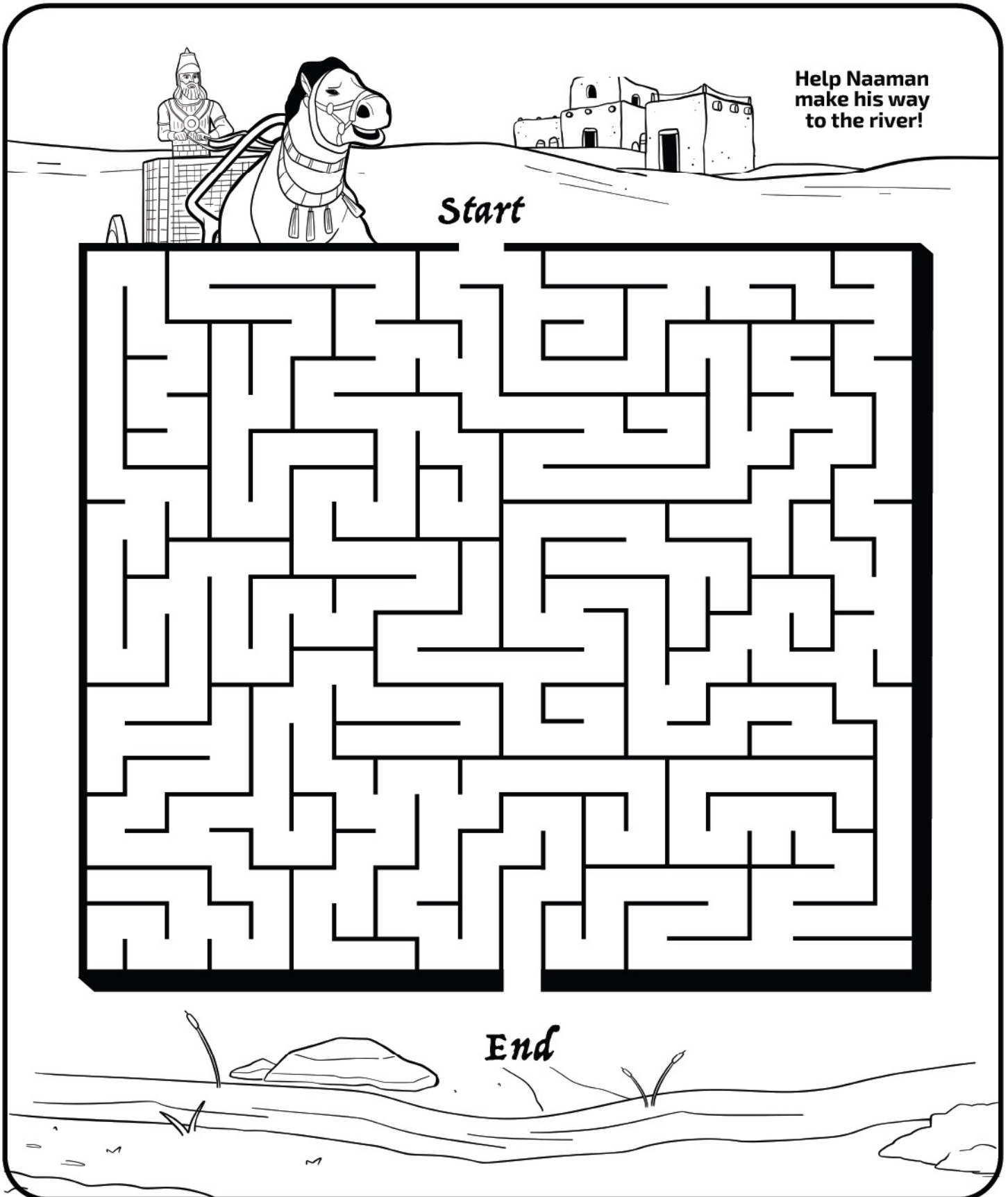
Step 3

No hands allowed: You and your partner will use the rope and rubber band to pick up and stack the cups one by one. See how high you can stack the cups!

Main Point:

This challenge gets more difficult as you stack the cups higher and higher. You may only get a few feet off the ground before it falls. Imagine the amount of hard work that went into building Solomon's Temple. The highest point of the temple was 120 cubits, or 207 feet, about as tall as a 20 story building.

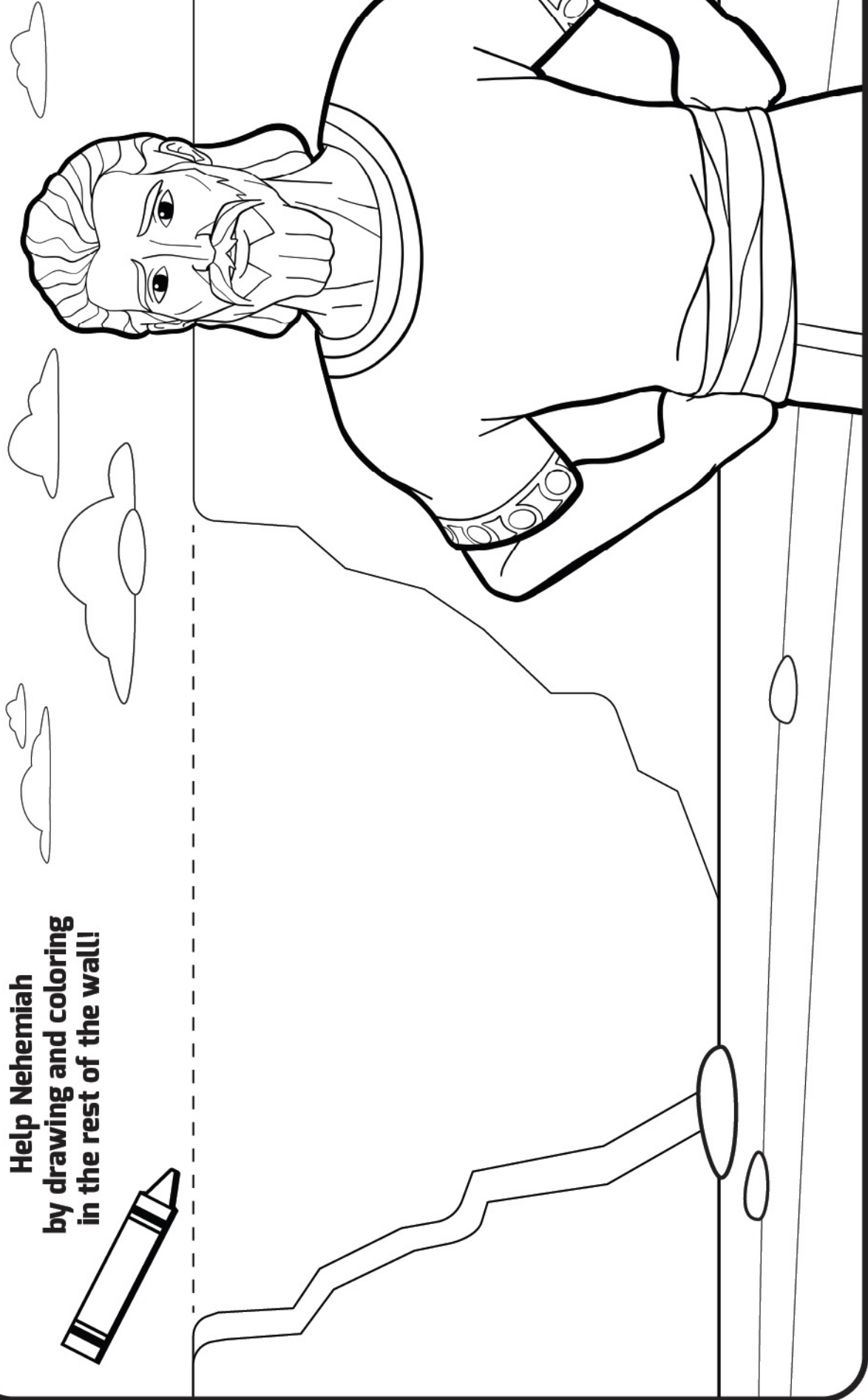

ITEMS NEEDED



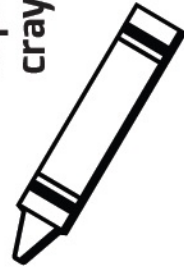
Code Breaker

Step 1

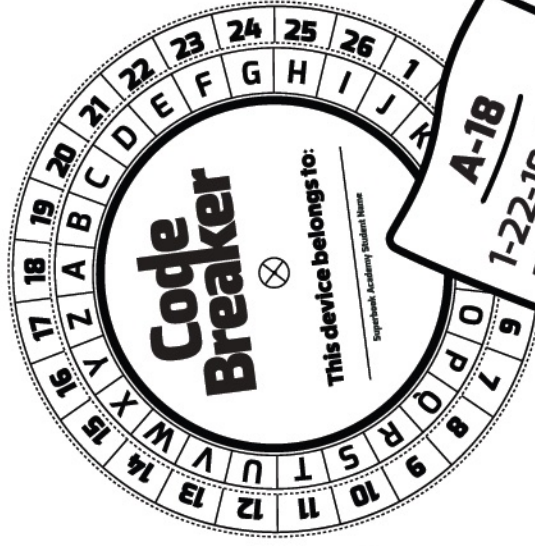
Print, cut out, and assemble the code breaker.

Step 2

Turn the smaller wheel on the code breaker to set your code and mark down where the letter "A" lands. (For example, if the "A" is next to the number 18, then you would write down A-18.

Step 3

Now if the code is set you can write a secret message using that code. Write down a number for each letter. For example, if you wanted to write J-E-S-U-S, with your code breaker set to A-18, you could write the numbers 1-22-10-12-10. See the image to right.

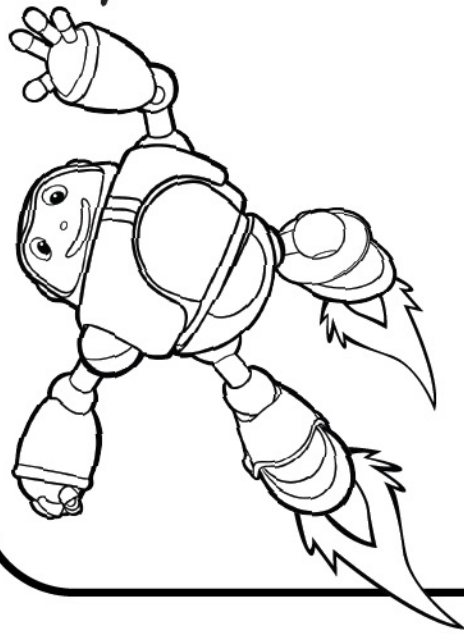


Cut along the dotted lines first. Carefully push a brass fastener through the center of both circles to connect the two circles. Make sure that the smaller circle is on top of the larger circle.

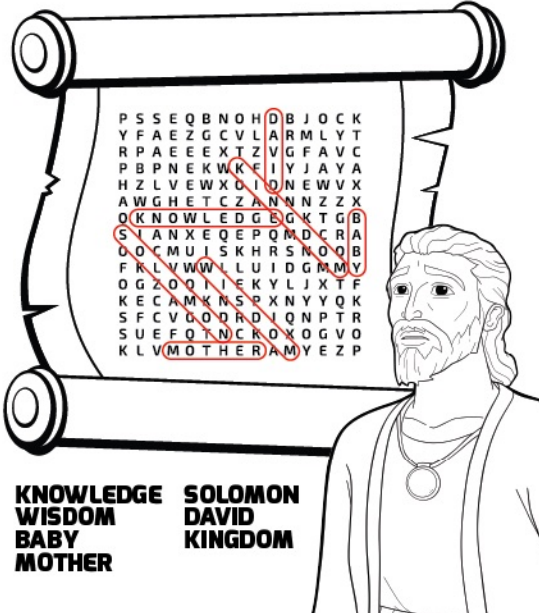

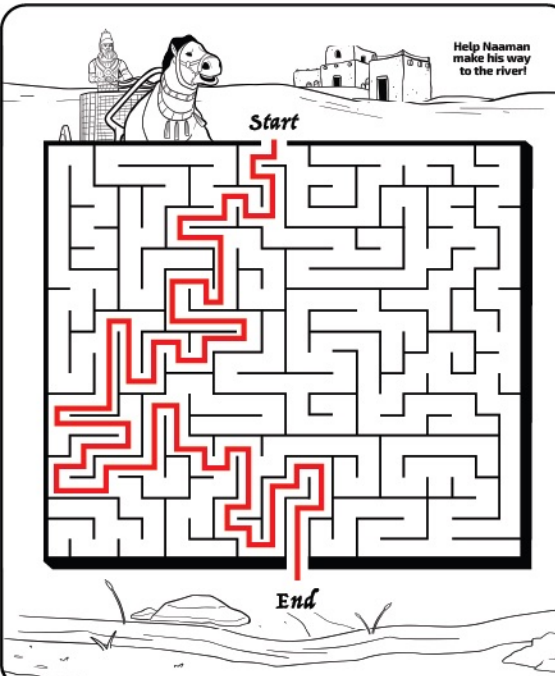

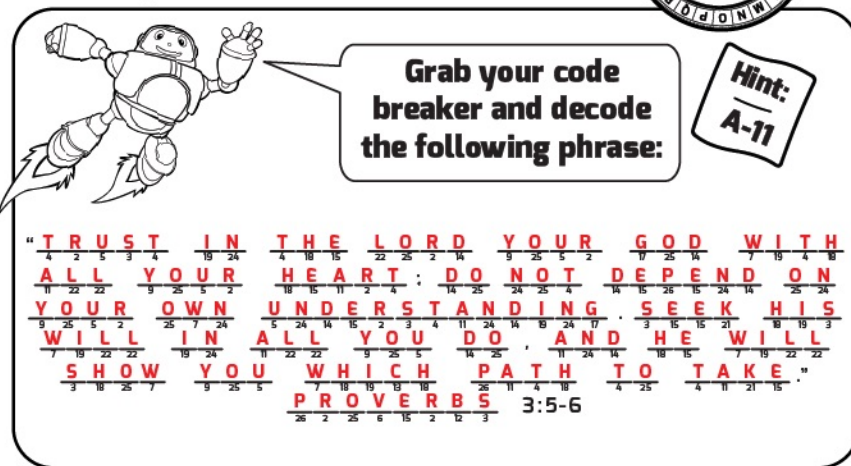
